Coastal then heads to UNC Wilmington (13-4) to take on the Seahawks Wednesday, March 19 at 7 p.m. That game can be viewed on www.UNCWSports.com. Coastal took 2-of-3 games this past weekend in the Centex Homes Invitational.

SCOUTING CLEMSON: The Tigers lost 2-of-3 games against Boston College this past weekend, but defeated the Eagles 16-2 in the final game of the series. **Wilson Boyd** leads the club with a .411 batting average and is one of three Tigers with five home runs on the season. Clemson will start lefty **Matt Zoltak** against the Chanticleers. Zoltak threw a scoreless inning June 4 in the final game of the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional against CCU. He has a 10 strikeouts in 14 innings this season.

SERIES VS. CLEMSON: Clemson owns a 36-6 series advantage, including winning three meetings last season. Clemson defeated the Chanticleers 4-0 March 7 in Clemson. The Tigers won 11-8 June 3 and 15-3 June 4 in the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional.

SCOUTING UNC WILMINGTON: The Seahawks are off to a 13-4 start, including a three-game sweep against Hofstra this past weekend. UNCW is receiving votes in two national polls and is a perfect 6-0 in the Colonial. **Mark Carver** leads the Seahawks with a .414 batting average and has 23 RBI. **Daniel Hargrave** has added seven home runs on the year.

SERIES VS. UNC WILMINGTON: Coastal leads the all-time series with UNC Wilmington 42-29. Coastal swept the season series with the Seahawks last year, winning in Conway 8-6 Feb. 14 and in Wilmington 7-6 March 13. **Derek Martin** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) was 2-for-3 with an RBI in the win at Wilmington, while **Nick McCully** (Lakeland, Fla./Santa Fe Catholic) struck out nine in a start at UNCW.

WEATHER FORECAST: Tuesday, Cloudy, 62 degrees. Wednesday, Partly Cloudy/Wind, low 70's.

REMATCH OF THE REGIONAL: The Coastal-Clemson game on Tuesday is a rematch of the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional championship game, won by the Tigers 15-3. Coastal was the first Big South school to host a regional, as the Chanticleers were the number-one seed for the second time in three years. The winner's bracket final against Clemson brought in 6,231 fans, a record at BB&T Coastal Field.

HAUG NAMED BIG SOUTH PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Coastal Carolina senior **Joey Haug** (Holt, Mo./Maple Woods C.C.) has been named New Balance Pitcher of the Week for games played March 10-16, it was announced March 16 by the League office.

Haug had a hand in two big Coastal wins over ranked opponents last week. He struck out a pair in 2.2 innings, allowing three hits and an unearned run in the 11-4 win at No. 3 North Carolina. Haug allowed two runs in two innings in a 4-1 loss against No. 25 Michigan, but came back the next day and earned the win over the Wolverines, striking out three and giving up just one hit. Haug had

five strikeouts on the week and did not allow a run in the three runners he inherited out of the bullpen.

COASTAL IN THE POLLS: Coastal Carolina is now ranked in five national polls as of March 16, coming in as high as eighth in the Ping!Baseball poll. Coastal is 18th in the NCBWA poll, 21st in both the Baseball America and the ESPN/USA Today poll and 27th in the Collegiate Baseball poll.

CHANT BEAT ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT: Coastal ended the Centex Homes Invitational with an 11-9 win over 25th-ranked Michigan. Coastal had to do it in come-from-behind fashion, taking a 10-9 lead in the seventh on a sacrifice fly from freshman **Scott Woodward** (Markle, Ind./Norwell). Junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) gave CCU an 11-9 cushion in the eighth with a solo home run. Coastal avenged a 4-1 loss on Saturday to the Wolverines.

DOYLE EARNS CONFERENCE, PLAYER OF THE WEEK, SPOTLIGHT PERFORMER HONOR: Coastal Carolina junior catcher **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) has been selected as the Big South Conference Choice Hotels Baseball Player of the Week, it was announced today by the League office. He also was the Spotlight Performer of the Week by Ping!Baseball. Doyle batted .500 (8-16) in four wins last week for Coastal, scoring three runs, belting three home runs and driving in 10 on the week. He started the week by going 2-for-3 with four RBI in the 13-6 win over Toledo. Doyle walked twice and hit a home run in the win over the Rockets. He was 5-for-9 with six RBI in the two games against Ball State. Doyle was 3-for-4 with a double and a home run in the 6-1 win March 8, and then went 2-for-5 with a double, home run and four RBI in the 10-8 win. His two-run double in the eighth inning brought in the game-winning runs. Doyle also slugged 1.188 on the week, had a .550 on-base percentage and threw out 2-of-3 runners trying to steal.

BALDRIDGE NAMED A CANDIDATE FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD: Coastal Carolina University baseball senior **Tommy Baldrige** (Fort Mill, S.C./Fort Mill) has been selected as a candidate for the Lowe's Baseball Senior CLASS Award, it was announced March 10. A national media committee will select 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in mid-April. Those 10 names will then be placed on the official ballot for a nationwide vote that will include coaches, media and fans. The award winner will be announced and recognized at the 2008 NCAA Men's College World Series in Omaha, Neb.

CHANTS BEAT #3 UNC 11-4: Coastal picked up a very impressive 11-4 win over third-ranked North Carolina March 11, improving its record to 13-1 on the year. Junior **David Anderson** (Lexington, S.C./White Knoll) improved his record to 3-0 on the mound and freshman **Rich Witten** (Danville, Ky./Danville) and sophomore **Chance Gilmore** (Surfside Beach, S.C./Virginia) had three RBI apiece in the win. The win is the second by Coastal over a top-five team in the last four years. Coastal defeated fifth-ranked Georgia Tech 7-6 May 10, 2005.

RPI WATCH: While it's very early in the RPI watch, Coastal is ninth in both the WarrenNolan.com and the Boyd's World rankings.

RIVALS POWER RANKING: Three Chanticleers are in the Rivals.com positional rankings, out March 10. Junior **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) is ranked the ninth best catcher in the nation by the website. In the outfield, junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) is 10th, while senior **Tommy Baldrige** (Fort Mill, S.C./Fort Mill) is 14th in the country.

TRIPLE PLAY!!!: Coastal completed a triple play in the 6-1 win over Ball State March 8. With two on and no one out, Matt Stoeklen hit a shot to second that freshman **Rico Noel** (Lawton, Okla./Lawton) skied for and grabbed. He then stepped on second to force out Justin Rogers and threw to first to retire Dean Anna for a triple play. It was the first triple play at Watson Stadium since 2005.

HOME RUN DERBY: Coastal took advantage of the strong winds blowing out to left field in the 6-1 win over Ball State March 8. The Chanticleers belted four home runs, three to left field, accounting for five of the six CCU runs. Sophomore **Adam Rice** (Murphy, Texas/Elgin C.C.) hit his third home run of the year, while junior **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) had two on the weekend and

The Coastal Carolina University baseball team has been unanimously voted the Big South Conference's preseason favorite, as voted by the League's Head Baseball Coaches and Sports Information Directors, it was announced today by the Conference office. In addition, junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) has been voted the Conference's Preseason Player of the Year while classmate **Bobby Gagg** (Hamburg, N.J./Walkkill) was voted the Pre-season Pitcher of the Year.

Coastal received all 16 first-place votes and the maximum 128 points to win the Big South in 2008. Coastal returns 15 letterwinners from last year's 50-13 squad (17-4 in Big South play) that hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional. The Chanticleers enter the 2008 campaign ranked 19th in the preseason Ping! Baseball poll as well as 30th by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA), 37th by Collegiate Baseball and 44th in the Perfect Game Cross-checker preseason ranking.

VMI followed Coastal in the preseason poll, as the Keydets collected 97 points to edge out third-place Liberty by one point. Winthrop was picked fourth with 88 points, while High Point finished fifth in the voting with 61 points. The Chanticleers have a 301-136 record, good for a .689 winning percentage. Rice leads the country with a .773 percentage. Coastal is above such schools as North Carolina, LSU and Miami in the list.

COASTAL TO VIDEO STREAM 23 GAMES: The Coastal Carolina University baseball team will have 23 of its games at Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field video streamed on THE EDGE at www.BigSouthSports.com this season. The schedule began with the season opener Feb. 22 against Maryland beginning at 4 p.m. Other highlights include eight of the nine home games against Big South opponents, two games against nationally-ranked Michigan March 15-16 and midweek contests versus Elon, the College of Charleston and Wake Forest. THE EDGE also will show every game of the 2008 Big South Baseball Tournament in Danville, Va.

Each game will cost \$4.95 or the baseball season package, which includes the Big South Game of the Week and other selected games by each conference school, will be \$29.95. The Big South Tournament can be viewed for \$6.95 per day or \$14.95 for the entire tournament.

Baseball and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA). Junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) was named a First Team All-Ping! Baseball member and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List. He also was named to the Third Team by Louisville Slugger. Junior **David Anderson** (Lexington, S.C./White Knoll) was named to the 2008 Stopper of the Year Watch List.

CHANTS PICKED TO WIN BIG SOUTH: The websites SouthEastern Baseball.com and Rivals.com as well as the College Baseball Insider have all picked Coastal to win the Big South. The Chanticleers also are picked 10th in SEBaseball's Top 80 teams in the Southeast. Coastal was unanimously picked to win the Big South by the League's coaches and sports information directors.

COASTAL HOSTS 2007 MYRTLE BEACH REGIONAL: Coastal became the first Big South school to host a regional, as the Chanticleers were the number-one seed for the second time in three years. Coastal advanced to the regional championship game, falling to Clemson in the finale. The winner's bracket final on June 3 brought in 6,231 fans, a record at BB&T Coastal Field. **Dock Doyle, Dom Duggan** and **Bobby Gagg** were named to the All-Myrtle Beach Regional team.

COASTAL WINS EIGHTH BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE: Coastal went unbeaten in the Big South Tournament, winning its eighth tournament title in school history. The Chanticleers won the title game 6-5 over Liberty as senior **Dom Duggan** hit the game-winning home run in the seventh inning. Coastal opened the tournament with a 6-3 win over UNC Asheville. The Chants defeated VMI 4-2 and Winthrop 13-4. Junior **Tommy Baldrige** was the tournament Most Valuable Player and he joined junior **Derek Martin**, sophomore **Tyler Bortnick**, senior **Adam Vrable**, senior **Matt Rademacher**, freshman **Nick McCully** and sophomore **Bobby Gagg** on the All-Tournament Team.

UP NEXT: Coastal hosts Albany in Coastal's first three-game series of the season March 21-23 at Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field. Friday's game begins at 6 p.m., with Saturday and Sunday's games at 2 and 1 p.m., respectively.

teams have averaged over 39 wins a year, including 11 40-plus win seasons. In his 12 years at Coastal, Gilmore's ball clubs have finished in the top four of the Big South Conference standings 11 times, including regular season titles in 1999, 2002, 2005 and 2007. Coastal also was one of only seven schools in Division I to win 40+ games from 2001-05. He has coached 55 All-Big South Conference players and five Big South Players of the Year, including Sappelt in 2007. Ryan McGraw also broke the NCAA single-season stolen base mark with 63 in 2002.

Coastal Carolina head coach **Gary Gilmore**, who is entering his 13th season with the Chanticleers, has seen the program continually rise in the world of college baseball to a national power. Six NCAA berths, seven 40+ win seasons in the last nine years, 10-straight winning seasons, numerous draft picks with more to come and a stadium that will become one of the nicest in the country are just a part of the exciting things going on in Coastal Carolina baseball.

GILMORE GRABS CAREER WIN #700 IN WIN OVER UNCA: Coastal head coach **Gary Gilmore** earned his 700th career win in a 10-2 victory over UNC Asheville May 12. Gilmore has a 725-367 record in his 19th season as a head coach. He also has a 472-265 record in his 13th season at Coastal. He earned his 400th win at Coastal May 12, 2006 at Radford and has helped Coastal to 40-win seasons seven of the last nine years and six NCAA regionals. Gilmore is one of only 39 active coaches in Division I baseball who have 700 wins.

Coastal enjoyed national success in 2007, as the Chanticleers hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time in school history and won 50 games for the second time in three seasons. Coastal won both the Big South Conference regular-season and tournament titles for the second time in six years, going 4-0 in the BSC Tournament and defeating Liberty 6-5 in the championship game. The Chanticleers had a 16-game winning streak in the middle of the season and the 13 losses were the fewest in Gilmore's 12 seasons in Conway. Gilmore was named the Midseason Coach of the Year by *Baseball America* and earned his fourth Big South Coach of the Year honor. He earned his 700th career win May 12 against UNC Asheville. Coastal hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional and its game against Clemson brought out 6,231 fans, a BB&T Coastal Field record. Bobby Gagg and David Sappelt earned All-America honors by *Collegiate Baseball*, while Sappelt was the Big South Player of the Year, Gagg was the Pitcher of the Year and Tommy Baldrige was the BSC Tournament Most Valuable Player. CCU ended the season ranked 20th by *Baseball America*. Gilmore also received a new contract in late June, keeping him as the head coach at CCU through at least 2015, including performance incentives and raises through the term of the contract. It will also provide increases in the Coastal baseball operating budget during that time.

In his 18 seasons as a college head coach, Gilmore's
