**SCOUTING ELON:** The Phoenix swept Furman this past weekend, improving their record to 7-2 in the Southern. **Chris Dove** is swinging a hot bat, hitting .391 with 20 runs-batted-in. **Bennett Davis** leads Elon in the power numbers, hitting 10 home runs and driving in 39 RBI. The Phoenix will throw **Cory Harrilchak** against Coastal. The lefty has struck out 20 batters in 27 innings pitched.

**SERIES VS. ELON:** Coastal leads the overall series with Elon 20-10, including winning both games in 2007. Coastal defeated the Phoenix 13-0 Feb. 10 and 6-3 March 20. Senior **Derek Martin** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) is 7-of-9 all-time against Elon.

**SCOUTING WAKE FOREST:** The Demon Deacons defeated Florida State 4-2 last Saturday in taking one game of the three-game series with the Seminoles. All-American **Allan Dykstra** has eight home runs and a .325 batting average for Wake, while **Dustin Hood** has a .330 average and 21 RBI. Wake will start **Ben Hunter** against the Chants. Hunter has been the Friday starter for the Demon Deacons and has 29 strikeouts in 31.1 innings pitched.

**SERIES VS. WAKE FOREST:** Wake leads the overall series with Coastal 12-9 and won both meetings last year 4-3 April 11 in Conway and 12-5 April 18 in Winston-Salem. Junior **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) has a .375 average against Wake Forest.

**HAUG NAMED BIG SOUTH PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Senior **Joey Haug** (Holt, Mo./Maple Woods C.C.) was named the New Balance Pitcher of the Week for the second time this season March 31. Haug had a hand in all three wins for Coastal Carolina last week, going 10 innings and allowing just two hits, no runs and striking out 13 batters. The senior pitched the last 3.2 innings in the 5-1 win over The Citadel March 25, striking out three batters and not allowing a hit in earning the save. Haug came in with the game tied at three in the fifth inning and held Liberty to just two hits and one intentional walk in 5.1 innings in the 5-3 win over the Flames Friday night. He struck out 10 batters, including six in a row, as the Chants earned the win in extra frames. Haug then came in with Coastal up 2-1 with a runner on first and no one out on Sunday and got a fly out and a game-ending double play to preserve the victory. Haug inherited four runners and did not allow one to score in his three appearances.

**CHANTS GET THEM ON, BUT CAN'T GET THEM IN:** Coastal hit just .206 with runners in scoring position in the three-game series against Liberty, but senior **Tommy Baldrige's** (Fort Mill, S.C./Fort Mill) had two hits in that situation, including a two-run single in the 11th in Coastal's 5-3 win over Liberty March 28.

**McCULLY THROWS GEM IN WIN OVER LIBERTY:** Sophomore **Nick McCully** (Lakeland, Fla./Santa Fe Catholic) threw eight-plus innings in Coastal's 2-1 win over Liberty March 30. He allowed just three hits and one run, while striking out four and improving his record to 4-1 on the year. McCully leads the team with 37 strikeouts on the year.

**WHEELER, HAUG SHUT DOWN BULLDOG**

**BATS:** Freshman **Cody Wheeler** (Spotsylvania, Va./Spotsylvania) and senior **Joey Haug** (Holt, Mo./Maple Woods C.C.) combined on a four-hitter with six strikeouts in a 5-1 win over The Citadel March 25. Wheeler allowed only four hits and one run in 5.1 innings, while Haug came in and did not allow a hit and had three strikeouts in 3.2 innings.

**WINTHROP SERIES:** Coastal will welcome back its baseball alumni for the Winthrop series April 4-6. The alumni will be able to take batting practice before the Saturday, April 5 game. There also will be prizes given out each inning, free food in the Teal Lot from 5-6 p.m. and a post-game fireworks show after Saturday's game.

**BATS COME OUT IN ALBANY SWEEP:**

Coastal hit .411 in the three-game sweep of Albany March 21-23. The Chanticleers pounded out 44 hits, eight of which came from junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance). Sappelt also had two home runs and eight RBI in the series. Fourteen different Chanticleers had at least one hit in the series and there were 17 extra-base hits in three games.

**NEW FACES SHINE IN ALBANY SERIES:**

Three Coastal players saw their first action in a Chanticleer uniform in the three-game series against Albany. Freshman **Dustin King** (Myrtle Beach, S.C./Carolina Forest) drove in two runs with a double in Saturday's 18-4 win over the Great Danes. Freshman **Paul Rodriguez** (Myrtle Beach, S.C./Carolina Forest) pitched the final inning of that game, striking out a batter in his first appearance. Freshman **Matt Rein** (Houston, Texas/Langham Creek) pitched the eighth inning of Sunday's 17-4 win, striking out a batter in an inning of work.

**WHEELER IMPRESSES IN CLEMSON GAME:** Freshman **Cody Wheeler** (Spotsylvania, Va./Spotsylvania) tied a career high with eight strikeouts in Coastal's 9-6 loss to Clemson. Wheeler pitched the final 6.2 innings, allowing just a double in the eighth, and now has 28 strikeouts in 25.1 innings pitched.

**HAUG NAMED BIG SOUTH PITCHER OF THE WEEK:** Coastal Carolina senior **Joey Haug** (Holt, Mo./Maple Woods C.C.) has been named New Balance Pitcher of the Week for games played March 10-16, it was announced March 16 by the League office.

Haug had a hand in two big Coastal wins over ranked opponents last week. He struck out a pair in 2.2 innings, allowing three hits and an unearned run in the 11-4 win at No. 3 North Carolina. Haug allowed two runs in two innings in a 4-1 loss against No. 25 Michigan, but came back the next day and earned the win over the Wolverines, striking out three and giving up just one hit. Haug had five strikeouts on the week and did not allow a run in the three runners he inherited out of the bullpen.

Haug is now 3-0 with two saves and a team-leading 1.14 ERA in 13 appearances.

**COASTAL IN THE POLLS:** Coastal is 22nd in the ESPN/USA Today poll, 24th in the Baseball America poll and 30th in the Collegiate Baseball poll.

**CHANTS BEAT ANOTHER RANKED OPPONENT:** Coastal ended the Centex Homes Invitational with an 11-9 win over 25th-ranked Michigan. Coastal had to do it in come-from-behind fashion, taking a 10-9 lead in the seventh on a sacrifice fly from freshman **Scott Woodward** (Markle, Ind./Norwell). Junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) gave CCU an 11-9 cushion in the eighth with a solo home run. Coastal avenged a 4-1 loss on Saturday to the Wolverines.

The Coastal Carolina University baseball team has been unanimously voted the Big South Conference's preseason favorite, as voted by the League's Head Baseball Coaches and Sports Information Directors, it was announced today by the Conference office. In addition, junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) has been voted the Conference's Preseason Player of the Year while classmate **Bobby Gagg** (Hamburg, N.J./Walkkill) was voted the Pre-season Pitcher of the Year.

Coastal received all 16 first-place votes and the maximum 128 points to win the Big South in 2008. Coastal returns 15 letterwinners from last year's 50-13 squad (17-4 in Big South play) that hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional. The Chanticleers enter the 2008 campaign ranked 19th in the preseason Ping! Baseball poll as well as 30th by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA), 37th by Collegiate Baseball and 44th in the Perfect Game Cross-checker preseason ranking.

**DRAFT DODGERS:** Coastal has five players on its roster that were taken in the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Redshirt junior **Pete Andreleczyk** (Lancaster, Pa./Manheim Twp.) was taken by the Baltimore Orioles in the 32nd round of the 2007 draft. Redshirt junior **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) was selected by the Atlanta Braves in the 44th round last season. Sophomore **Austin Fleet** (Edmond, Okla./Santa Fe) was taken in the 2006 draft by the Atlanta Braves and freshman **Chad Jenkins** (Newark, Del./Caravel Academy) was picked by the Washington Nationals in this past summer's draft. Sophomore **Jim Birmingham** (Pine Hill, N.J./Overbrook (Penn)) was taken by the Nationals in the 25th round in 2006.

**WATSON STADIUM/VROOMAN FIELD UNDERGOES CHANGES IN OFFSEASON:** Fans entering Charles Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field for the home opener Feb. 22 against Maryland noticed a difference in the field and in the stands to the Chanticleer baseball home. Coastal has added chairback seats throughout the grandstand, replacing the bleachers that were in all but the first three rows of the concourse. Fans will have a better view of the game, as a new net on the backstop eliminated most of the poles between the fans and the field. Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field also has new Field Turf in foul territory in the infield and behind home plate. The home bullpen area also has new Field Turf. There also was a significant upgrade to the clubhouse, including new lockers and a new training room.

**WHO'S BACK:** Coastal returns five position starters and nine pitchers from last year's 50-13 team. Outfielders **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) and **Tommy Baldrige** (Fort Mill, S.C./Fort Mill) return along with shortstop **Tyler Bortnick** (Mentor, Ohio/Mentor), third baseman **Derek Martin** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) and first baseman/designated hitter **David Anderson** (Lexington, S.C./White Knoll). Catcher **Dock Doyle** (Conway, S.C./Conway) also returns after starting 37 games behind the plate last season. Junior **Bobby Gagg** (Hamburg, N.J./Walkill) anchors a pitching staff that also returns Anderson and sophomore **Nick McCully** (Lakeland, Fla./Santa Fe Catholic) in the rotation.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE FACES CHANTS:** Coastal Carolina will play five teams ranked in the *Collegiate Baseball* Preseason Top-30 along with 13 games against the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) in the 2008 schedule. Coastal will host Michigan for two games in the Centex Homes Invitational March 15-16. Michigan is ranked as high as eighth in the *Baseball America* poll. Coastal also has midweek games against North Carolina, Clemson, North Carolina State, Virginia and Wake Forest and has a three-game series at Georgia Tech May 2-4.

**MARTIN TO START FIFTH SEASON FOR CHANTS:** Redshirt senior **Derek Martin** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) starts his fifth and final season in a Coastal Carolina uniform. Martin has a career .271 batting average with 23 doubles, five home runs and 93 runs-batted-in in 162 games. Martin played only three games in 2005 due to injury, earning a redshirt. **Tommy Baldrige** (Fort Mill, S.C./Fort Mill) and **Joey Haug** (Holt, Mo./Plattsburg (Maple Woods C.C.)) are Coastal's other true seniors. Baldrige has a .358 career batting average with 17 home runs and 93 RBI, while Haug was 1-0 with a 3.66 earned-run average in his first season at Coastal in 2007.

teams have averaged over 39 wins a year, including 11 40-plus win seasons. In his 12 years at Coastal, Gilmore's ball clubs have finished in the top four of the Big South Conference standings 11 times, including regular season titles in 1999, 2002, 2005 and 2007. Coastal also was one of only seven schools in Division I to win 40+ games from 2001-05. He has coached 55 All-Big South Conference players and five Big South Players of the Year, including Sappelt in 2007. Ryan McGraw also broke the NCAA single-season stolen base mark with 63 in 2002.

Coastal Carolina head coach **Gary Gilmore**, who is entering his 13th season with the Chanticleers, has seen the program continually rise in the world of college baseball to a national power. Six NCAA berths, seven 40+ win seasons in the last nine years, 10-straight winning seasons, numerous draft picks with more to come and a stadium that will become one of the nicest in the country are just a part of the exciting things going on in Coastal Carolina baseball.

Coastal enjoyed national success in 2007, as the Chanticleers hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time in school history and won 50 games for the second time in three seasons. Coastal won both the Big South Conference regular-season and tournament titles for the second time in six years, going 4-0 in the BSC Tournament and defeating Liberty 6-5 in the championship game. The Chanticleers had a 16-game winning streak in the middle of the season and the 13 losses were the fewest in Gilmore's 12 seasons in Conway. Gilmore was named the Midseason Coach of the Year by *Baseball America* and earned his fourth Big South Coach of the Year honor. He earned his 700th career win May 12 against UNC Asheville. Coastal hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional and its game against Clemson brought out 6,231 fans, a BB&T Coastal Field record. Bobby Gagg and David Sappelt earned All-America honors by *Collegiate Baseball*, while Sappelt was the Big South Player of the Year, Gagg was the Pitcher of the Year and Tommy Baldrige was the BSC Tournament Most Valuable Player. CCU ended the season ranked 20th by *Baseball America*. Gilmore also received a new contract in late June, keeping him as the head coach at CCU through at least 2015, including performance incentives and raises through the term of the contract. It will also provide increases in the Coastal baseball operating budget during that time.

In his 18 seasons as a college head coach, Gilmore's

**GILMORE GRABS CAREER WIN #700 IN WIN OVER UNCA:** Coastal head coach **Gary Gilmore** earned his 700th career win in a 10-2 victory over UNC Asheville May 12. Gilmore has a 731-371 record in his 19th season as a head coach. He also has a 478-269 record in his 13th season at Coastal. He earned his 400th win at Coastal May 12, 2006 at Radford and has helped Coastal to 40-win seasons seven of the last nine years and six NCAA regionals. Gilmore is one of only 39 active coaches in Division I baseball who have 700 wins.
