The 34rd season of Coastal Carolina University baseball opens Feb. 22-24 as the Chanticleers host the IMICHotels.com INN-vitational at Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field. Coastal welcomes Pittsburgh, Virginia Tech and Maryland for seven games over three days. Coastal plays Maryland Friday at 4 p.m., and Saturday at 1:30 p.m. CCU then faces Virginia Tech Saturday at 5 p.m., and Sunday at 2:30 p.m. Coastal is coming off a 50-win season and a top-seed in the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional, returning five positional starters and nine pitchers to this year's squad.

SCOUTING MARYLAND: The Terrapins return nine starters and eight pitchers from last year's team that went 26-30 overall and 7-23 in the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). Maryland tied for 11th in the conference, but returns its top hitter in **AJ Casario**, who hit .331 with 28 RBI in 2007. Maryland did lose **Brett Cecil**, who saved eight games last year and was drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 1st round. Maryland will throw George Washington transfer **Scott Swinson** on Friday and junior college transfer **Jensen Pupa** on Saturday.

SERIES VS. MARYLAND: Coastal has a 6-3 series advantage on the Terrapins, but the two teams have not met on the diamond since 1990. Maryland won both games of that series 9-0 and 7-3. All nine games have been played at Coastal, with the Chants winning the first five contests.

SCOUTING VIRGINIA TECH: The Hokies return seven position players and four pitchers from last year's team that went 23-31 overall and 7-23 in the ACC. **Sean O'Brien** returns after hitting .327 with 32 RBI last season, while **Jose Cueto** had four home runs for the Hokies in 2007. The Hokies will pitch freshmen **Sean McDermott** and **Jesse Hahn** against the Chanticleers. McDermott went 25-2 in his career at Walpole High School in Massachusetts, while Hahn was All-State in 2007 at Fitch High School in Groton, Conn.

SERIES VS. VIRGINIA TECH: Coastal leads the overall series with Virginia Tech 2-1 and won an exciting 6-5 game in last year's IMICHotels.com INN-vitational Feb. 18. The Hokies scored four runs in the top of the ninth to take a 5-4 lead, but **Derek Martin's** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) single in the bottom of the frame brought home the winning run as the Chants improved to 7-0 on the year. **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) went 4-for-4 with two RBI in the win.

WEATHER FORECAST: Friday: 70 percent chance of thunderstorms, High of 57. Saturday: 30 percent chance of showers, High of 65. Sunday: Partly cloudy, High of 67.

SEASON OPENER HISTORY: Coastal is 20-12 all-time in season openers, dating back to the 1976 season. Last season, the Chanticleers defeated North Florida 8-1 in the season opener, as Coastal has now won eight of its last nine openers. In that game against the Ospreys, **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alabama) went 3-for-5 at the plate, while Andy DeLaGarza allowed just five hits in seven innings pitched.

OPENING DAY FOR ALL: February 22nd will be opening day for all teams this season, after the NCAA added a mandated start day for the 2008 season. This will be the latest the Chanticleers have started since the 1985 season, when CCU opened Feb. 26 against Charleston Southern.

The Coastal Carolina University baseball team has been unanimously voted the Big South Conference's preseason favorite, as voted by the League's Head Baseball Coaches and Sports Information Directors, it was announced today by the Conference office. In addition, junior **David Sappelt** (Saxapahaw, N.C./Southern Alamance) has been voted the Conference's Preseason Player of the Year while classmate **Bobby Gagg** (Hamburg, N.J./Walkill) was voted the Pre-season Pitcher of the Year.

Coastal received all 16 first-place votes and the maximum 128 points to win the Big South in 2008. Coastal returns 15 letterwinners from last year's 50-13 squad (17-4 in Big South play) that hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional. The Chanticleers enter the 2008 campaign ranked 19th in the preseason Ping! Baseball poll as well as 30th by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA), 37th by Collegiate Baseball and 44th in the Perfect Game Cross-checker preseason ranking.

VMI followed Coastal in the preseason poll, as the Keydets collected 97 points to edge out third-place Liberty by one point. Winthrop was picked fourth with 88 points, while High Point finished fifth in the voting with 61 points. UNC Asheville received 56 points for sixth place, while Charleston Southern and Radford tied for seventh place in the preseason poll with 25 points each.

TOUGH SCHEDULE FACES CHANTS: Coastal Carolina will play five teams ranked in the *Collegiate Baseball* Preseason Top-30 along with 13 games against the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) in the 2008 schedule. Coastal will host Michigan for two games in the Centex Homes Invitational March 15-16. Michigan is ranked as high as eighth in the *Baseball America* poll. Coastal also has midweek games against North Carolina, Clemson, North Carolina State, Virginia and Wake Forest and has a three-game series at Georgia Tech May 2-4.

MARTIN TO START FIFTH SEASON FOR CHANTS: Redshirt senior **Derek Martin** (Barnwell, S.C./Barnwell) starts his fifth and final season in a Coastal Carolina uniform. COASTAL HOSTS 2007 MYRTLE BEACH REGIONAL: Coastal became the first Big South school to host a regional, as the Chanticleers were the number-one seed for the second time in three years. Coastal advanced to the regional championship game, falling to Clemson in the finale. The winner's bracket final on June 3 brought in 6,231 fans, a record at BB&T Coastal Field. **Dock Doyle, Dom Duggan** and **Bobby Gagg** were named to the All-Myrtle Beach Regional team.

COASTAL WINS EIGHTH BIG SOUTH TOURNAMENT TITLE: Coastal went unbeaten in the Big South Tournament, winning its eighth tournament title in school history. The Chanticleers won the title game 6-5 over Liberty as senior **Dom Duggan** hit the game-winning home run in the seventh inning. Coastal opened the tournament with a 6-3 win over UNC Asheville. The Chants defeated VMI 4-2 and Winthrop 13-4. Junior **Tommy Baldrige** was the tournament Most Valuable Player and he joined junior **Derek Martin**, sophomore **Tyler Bortnick**, senior **Adam Vrale**, senior **Matt Rademacher**, freshman **Nick McCully** and sophomore **Bobby Gagg** on the All-Tournament Team.

COASTAL WINS 10TH REGULAR-SEASON TITLE: For the 10th time in school history, Coastal Carolina won the Big South Conference regular-season title. The Chanticleers wrapped up the crown with its 7-2 win over Winthrop May 20. Coastal last won the title in 2005 and have won four of the last nine years. Coastal won all seven Big South series in 2007, a feat the Chants also accomplished in 2005.

teams have averaged over 39 wins a year, including 11 40-plus win seasons. In his 12 years at Coastal, Gilmore's ball clubs have finished in the top four of the Big South Conference standings 11 times, including regular season titles in 1999, 2002, 2005 and 2007. Coastal also was one of only seven schools in Division I to win 40+ games from 2001-05. He has coached 55 All-Big South Conference players and five Big South Players of the Year, including Sappelt in 2007. Ryan McGraw also broke the NCAA single-season stolen base mark with 63 in 2002.

Coastal Carolina head coach **Gary Gilmore**, who is entering his 13th season with the Chanticleers, has seen the program continually rise in the world of college baseball to a national power. Six NCAA berths, seven 40+ win seasons in the last nine years, 10-straight winning seasons, numerous draft picks with more to come and a stadium that will become one of the nicest in the country are just a part of the exciting things going on in Coastal Carolina baseball.

GILMORE GRABS CAREER WIN #700 IN WIN OVER UNCA: Coastal head coach **Gary Gilmore** earned his 700th career win in a 10-2 victory over UNC Asheville May 12. Gilmore has a 710-365 record in his 18th season as a head coach. He also has a 457-263 record in his 12th season at Coastal. He earned his 400th win at Coastal May 12, 2006 at Radford and has helped Coastal to 40-win seasons seven of the last nine years and six NCAA regionals. Gilmore is one of only 39 active coaches in Division I baseball who have 700 wins.

Coastal enjoyed national success in 2007, as the Chanticleers hosted an NCAA Regional for the first time in school history and won 50 games for the second time in three seasons. Coastal won both the Big South Conference regular-season and tournament titles for the second time in six years, going 4-0 in the BSC Tournament and defeating Liberty 6-5 in the championship game. The Chanticleers had a 16-game winning streak in the middle of the season and the 13 losses were the fewest in Gilmore's 12 seasons in Conway. Gilmore was named the Midseason Coach of the Year by *Baseball America* and earned his fourth Big South Coach of the Year honor. He earned his 700th career win May 12 against UNC Asheville. Coastal hosted the 2007 Myrtle Beach Regional and its game against Clemson brought out 6,231 fans, a BB&T Coastal Field record. Bobby Gagg and David Sappelt earned All-America honors by *Collegiate Baseball*, while Sappelt was the Big South Player of the Year, Gagg was the Pitcher of the Year and Tommy Baldrige was the BSC Tournament Most Valuable Player. CCU ended the season ranked 20th by *Baseball America*. Gilmore also received a new contract in late June, keeping him as the head coach at CCU through at least 2015, including performance incentives and raises through the term of the contract. It will also provide increases in the Coastal baseball operating budget during that time.

In his 18 seasons as a college head coach, Gilmore's
