(80 x 100 High Jump area with 22 x 11 pit) (180' PV runway) (2 shot circles)
(AAE Hammer/Discus Cage is dedicated to throws landing field)

FLATS OR 1/4" SPIKES ONLY

ELIGIBILITY: The meet is open to NCAA, NAIA, NJCC men and women, CLUB AND UNATTACHED athletes. Due to NCAA regulations no HS athletes are allowed to compete.

ENTRY FEE: \$300.00 PER GENDER TEAM / \$600.00 MENS AND WOMENS COMBINED TEAMS
Teams are defined as 10 or more athletes. Unattached competitors or teams with less than 10 athletes will be charged \$25.00 per individual. Teams entering only relays will be charged \$40.00 per relay team (event). Entry fees are based on the number of athletes entered in the meet by the entry deadline.

Entry Deadline is 12:00pm noon Wednesday April 9, 2008
An entry list will be posted by 12:00pm noon Thursday April 10, 2008

SCRATCHES: Scratch Deadline 12:00pm noon Thursday April 10, 2008
Scratches and corrections only after April 9, 2008

MINIMUM MARKS The hammer, discus and javelin will have a minimum measured mark of 30m.
Only the **first** legal mark under minimum will be measured.

MEET FORMAT: NCAA rules apply in all events. Running events will be sections on a time basis and seeded fastest to slowest. We will not run ahead of schedule. The final time schedule may be adjusted based on the number of entries. Field events will be seeded by flight shortest to longest. In the LJ, TJ, SP, DISC, JAV, and HAMMER all competitors will receive 3 attempts, the top 9 competitors will advance to a final flight for 3 more attempts.

OPENING HEIGHTS: Women's HJ – 4' 9" (1.45m), Women's PV – 9' 0.25" (2.75m), Men's HJ – 6' 0.75" (1.85m),
Men's PV – 12' 1.5" (3.70m), Progression: HJ (5cm), PV (15cm)

CHECK-IN: All athletes in the running events must check in with the clerk no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time for their event to get hip numbers. Field events athletes must check in for their event no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of their event. Heat sheets will be provided in the team packet. **The 200m and 4x400m relays will be seeded after check-in, athletes in these events must check-in 30 minutes before the event or they will be scratched.**

WARM-UP AREAS: All warm-ups will be done **outside the fenced track area**. (There is a large intramural field across from the track for this purpose). There are to be no athletes on the infield unless they are actively competing in an ongoing field event.

RESULTS: Finish Lynx - Hy-Tek will be used for results. Results will be posted on result board near the clerking area. Results will be posted at **www.goccusports.com** and **www.directathletics.com**

- FACILITIES:** Showers will be available upon request. There will be portable toilets near the track. Please do not use the campus buildings for bathrooms.
- WEIGH-INS:** Athletes are expected to provide their own implements. Implements will be inspected and weighed for NCAA compliance prior to competition. Weigh-in for all implements will take place at the track from 8:00 am-12:00 noon on Saturday.
- SCHEDULE:** See attached tentative time schedule. Please note schedule is tentative and may be modified due to weather or larger than expected entry. We will not run any event ahead of its currently scheduled time, unless inclement weather or impending inclement weather becomes a problem.
